Dear Steve,

I'm writing to inform you that the American Herbal Products Association's Board of Trustees adopted a motion at its meeting on June 28, 2017 to encourage AHPA members that market dietary supplement products under their own brands to submit labels for inclusion in at least one of the two now extant and publicly available dietary supplement label databases. The AHPA board had previously acted to encourage such members to submit labels for inclusion in the Dietary Supplement Label Database maintained by the National Library of Medicine and the Office of Dietary Supplements at the National Institutes of Health. The board's June decision has now extended this position to also specifically identify the Council for Responsible Nutrition's Supplement Online Wellness Library (Supplement OWL).

Moving forward, AHPA will continue to offer constructive feedback on this self-regulatory initiative. Please feel free to contact me at any time to discuss this further.
